CUSTOMER COMPLAINTS

We have received two (2) complaints since the date of my last report. Complaint No. 2019-46 was submitted to Comcast on behalf of a Birmingham resident who has been having a problem with his cable service for the last two years as it occasionally switches over to Spanish language. This occurs mostly when he is watching pro football and sometimes when he is watching PBS. The commercials, however, continue to be in English during this time. The escalation team representative made multiple attempts to contact this customer but was unsuccessful. They have provided their direct contact information if further assistance is needed and this complaint is now closed. Complaint No. 2019-45 was previously was received from a Birmingham resident who is trying to get AT&T to remove its wire from an old pole on his property and relocated onto a new pole so that DTE can then remove the old pole. AT&T sent a technician out a few weeks ago who told the homeowner they would be back but no one from the company has come back out to finalize this work. This complaint has been escalated again and is currently pending.

FINANCIAL

CHECK DISBURSEMENT

Two (2) checks have been written since the date of our last meeting as follows:

- 2. Michigan Municipal Risk Management Authority (2nd installment for liability insurance): \$2,313.00

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- TV Technology reported on January 3, 2020 that some viewers of the Citrus Bowl (Michigan v Alabama) received a Spanish broadcast on ABC. The Citrus Bowl released a statement via Twitter advising viewers to consult their TV provider "as we have no control over issues of this matter."
- 2. NATOA issued an update indicating that in a surprise move by Congress, the recent appropriations bill that funds the government through September 2020 also includes a new law that mandates that cable companies tell their customers the truth about cable pricing. Labeled as the Television Viewer Protection Act of 2019, the law requires a cable provider to notify customers buying a new plan within 24 hours "by phone, in person, online or by other reasonable means" of the full cost of buying the service. Customers then have 24 hours from the time the cable company sends the notice to cancel the service with no penalty. Interestingly, the law only affects cable TV pricing and not pricing for broadband or telephone service. The law gives cable companies six months to implement the new practices. Oddly, it also allows the FCC to extend the starting date by up to six additional months.
